

Clean claims submission tips for professional providers

Blue Shield of California uses **taxonomy codes** to identify provider specialties, so it is important to include this information when you file claims.* This is especially important for multispecialty groups and dual-licensed providers, but it applies to all professional providers. Note that claims from group practices submitted without the performing or rendering taxonomy code in Box 24J will be rejected.
