## **How to Improve HEDIS® Scores**

- Educate patients about the importance of early detection and encourage testing.
- Request a focused list of members who need a mammogram from your Blue Shield Promise Quality Program Manager.
- If the patient had a bilateral mastectomy, document it in the medical record.
- Schedule a mammogram for patient or send/give patient a referral/script, if needed.
- Have a list of mammogram facilities with phone numbers for calling and making an appointment, available to share with the patient.
- Engage patient in discussion of their fears about mammograms and let them know these tests are less uncomfortable and use less radiation than in the past.
