### How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Request a focused list of members who need a Pap test from your Blue Shield Promise Quality Program Manager.
- Use a reminder/recall system.
- Request Pap test results be sent to you if done at OB/GYN visit.
- Document in the medical record if the patient has had a hysterectomy with no residual cervix.
- Do not miss opportunities. For example, complete Pap tests during regularly scheduled well woman visits, sick visits, urine pregnancy tests, UTI and Chlamydia/STI screening.
