How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Update patient history annually regarding colorectal cancer screening (test done and a date).
- Encourage patients who are resistant to having a colonoscopy to have a stool test that they can complete at home.
- Use standing orders and empower office staff to distribute FOBT or sDNA/FIT kits to patients who need colorectal cancer screening or prepare referral for colonoscopy.
- Document patients with ileostomies, which implies colon removal and patients with a history of colon cancer.
- Request a focused list of members who need a colorectal cancer screening from your Blue Shield Promise Quality Program Manager.
